

REFLECTION

John 17:1-11 (7th Sunday of Easter)



Jesus gathers his disciples in prayer as he is about to be glorified through his passion, death, and resurrection. Jesus knows that his "hour" has come, the *kairos* moment when he will fulfill his mission on earth. Jesus has accomplished the work that has been given to him, that of revealing the one, eternal, merciful, ever-present God who is "Father" of all. Through Jesus' words and deeds, he has revealed God's glory to his followers, and now he prays for all who will glorify him by continuing his work on earth.

Before Jesus' Ascension to heaven, he promises his followers that they will receive power from the Holy Spirit to be his witnesses to the ends of the earth. Like the apostles, we must wait and pray for the fulfillment of the promise. We gather to pray with Mary, the mother of the church. Filled with the Spirit from the moment of Jesus' conception, she prays at the birth of the church. Peter reminds us that though we share in Christ's sufferings, we will rejoice when his glory is revealed. Jesus has entrusted us with the message. Empowered with his eternal presence, we will not fail him.

For Reflection: Do I pray for the Spirit to guide and direct my parish community? How has my work given glory to God?


