

> THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

John 3:16-18 (The Most Holy Trinity) Our belief in one God revealed in three divine personsather, Son and Spirit-cannot be understood by our intellect

Father, Son and Spirit-cannot be understood by our intellect alone. The Trinity is about relationship-the creative, the sacrificial, and the empowering love of God for us. It is essential for our Christian belief to know that it is love, not condemnation, that motivated God to send the Son to redeem the world from everything that is evil and destructive. The mercy of God and the love of Christ bind us together through the power of the Holy Spirit. The sign of peace that we offer is a kind of sacrament, a way to reveal God's love to one another. Paul concludes his letter to the Corinthians, "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (2 Cor 13:13). Each person has a choice to respond to this grace or to turn away from it. When every person becomes a place where God's love is revealed, the triune God will be exalted to the highest heaven and in the depths of the earth.

For Reflection: In what ways is my life marked by the sign of the cross, the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit?

OLM Book Sale


