

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

Matthew 17:1-9

Sunglasses have become so much a fashion accessory that we sometimes forget their real purpose. They make us comfortable in bright light and protect our eyes. The transfiguration of Jesus would surely be a "sunglasses moment" for Peter, James and John!

Before the three apostles' very eyes, Jesus' face "shown like the sun" and "his clothes became white as light." These images convey more than ordinary brightness, however, from which we naturally want to shield our eyes. Jesus was **transfigured**; he was entirely changed. Something completely new was happening, and it would happen to the apostles as well.

Peter wanted to "keep his sunglasses on": to pitch tents and stay in the brightness and promise of the transfiguration; but this could not be. The apostles had to come "down from the mountain" and travel with Jesus to Jerusalem, through their denial and doubts, through the old and into the new. Only then could they grasp the extent to which God desired to draw them into divine Life, into a new covenant and a new relationship.

In Jesus' transfiguration, Peter, James and John saw their own transformation. **And so do we.**


