

#### **REFLECTION**



Matthew 23:1-12

"They love places of honor..."

I confess I appreciate being recognized. Which of us does not like a compliment, especially if deep down we suspect it might be true? There is something about us that is worthy of note after all—and someone noticed!

There is a cavernous gap, however, between the simple joy of being affirmed as a person, and the demand to be recognized as someone more worthy than others. The heart of the matter, however, seems not to be the distinctions we love to heap upon ourselves, but the fact that we miss our brother and sisterhood when we do. If we are not brother and sister in Christ, what is it we hope to be in relations to each other?

When titles and honorifics substitute pride for relationship, it is a sad, lonely bargain. There are those who truly deserve the titles, and in the Church we sometimes have a way of multiplying titles and super-stressing honorifics. But the bottom line is that when they distinguish between those who have received the greatest of all dignities in baptism, they bring dishonor to the call to discipleship.

For Reflection: Am I numbered among those who love places of honor? Is this a healthy appreciation of the gifts I have been given or a dangerous flirtation with false security?
