## THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



Matthew 25:14-30

God's faithfulness is akin to a marriage relationship that lasts forever. A human example of fidelity is the "proverbial" wife. She is an unfailing prize, worth more than any treasure one might seek. She is a "vine" that nourishes those she loves with the fruit of her labors. She works untiringly in love and service to the unfortunate. Physical beauty is fleeting, but inner beauty is a treasure to be prized. It is everlasting and does not fade.

Paul warns us that we need to be untiring in our labors as well. We must be prepared for the day of the Lord that will come when least expected. Although no one can predict the time of the Lord's arrival, we are not left in the dark. We are children of light who keep awake and alert, ready for his coming whenever he appears.

Jesus tells us that he will come back to judge the church. He is like a man who went on a long journey to a far country, entrusting his servants to carry on his work. When he returned, he expected them to make an accounting. Were they good stewards of their time, talents and treasure or did they bury them? If Gods' gifts were used for the common good, God's servants would share their master's joy. If they did not invest wisely, they would find no place in God's reign.

For Reflection: Do I use my gifts to benefit others? Am I wisely using the time given to me?
