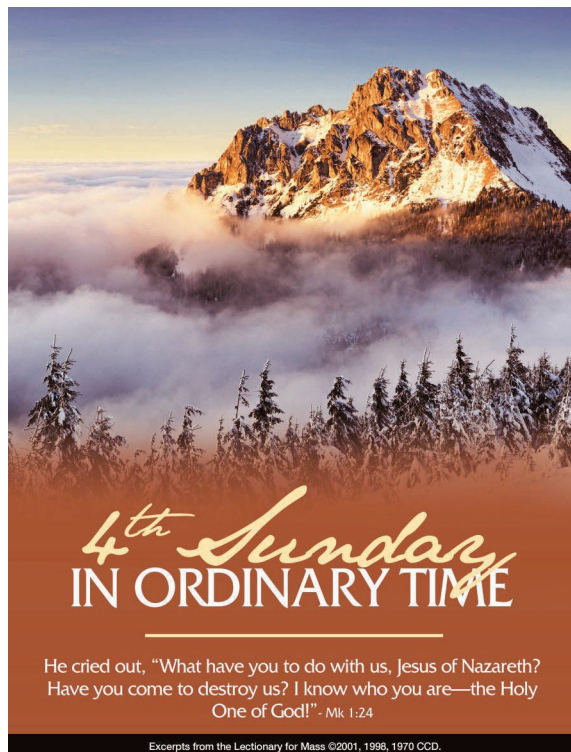

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

Mark 1:21-28



The people who heard God speak on their journey through the wilderness were afraid of the demands God made on their lives. They said “Let us not hear again the voice of the Lord.” Because the people refused to listen, God would raise up a prophet from among their own kinsmen, to whom they must listen. They must not harden their hearts as in the desert.

Jesus came to speak God's words of healing, justice, love, and people. He spoke words of deliverance to those constrained by sin. All who witnessed the liberation of those in torment were amazed at the one who taught with the authority of the prophets. Even the demons acknowledged Jesus's power over the forces of evil.

Paul believed that the time was short for him to proclaim the gospel. Everything, even the dearest human relationships, must be laid aside if they prevented him from obeying God's call.

For Reflection: Do I listen to the words Jesus speaks in the Scriptures? What am I willing to sacrifice to obey his voice?

"LORD, MAKE ME WHOLE" LENTEN PARISH MISSION WITH DAN SCHUTTE - March 11-13 at 7p.m.

Our parish is collaborating with our neighboring parishes (Our Lady of Mercy, Saint Gregory, Saint Mark/Mt. Calvary and Saint James), to welcome Dan Schutte for our Lenten Parish Mission. The title of Dan's three-night mission is "Lord, Make Me Whole." Lent is the time of the Church's annual retreat: a time to examine our life of faith, a time to focus on our relationship with the Lord and beseech God to make us whole.

Our Parish Mission is **Sunday thru Tuesday, March 11,12 & 13 at 7p.m.** On these evenings, Dan will weave together his music and the spiritual reflections behind them.

Steeped in Sacred Scripture and Ignatian spirituality, Dan Schutte's music has anchored people of faith for generations.
