



are involved in on of these ministries. The Library Ministry is looking for a new administrator to manage our book collection. See Donna Clark for more information.


### **Religious Education Registration**

## THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



Mk 6:30-34

The prophet Jeremiah had angry words for leaders who failed to care for God's people. He compared them to shepherds that did not protect their flocks and put them in danger. Because they were negligent in their duties, God would appoint new shepherds who would do what was right in the land. In God's pastures of plenty, God's people would find rest and refreshment.

Jesus revealed God's compassion for all who felt like "sheep without a shepherd," with no one to guide them. He is the righteous shepherd who, like the shepherd-king David, loved and cared for his people. In Jesus, we are brought near to God and to one another. All barriers and obsticles that keep us apart are torn down. When we are hungry and weary of life's burdens, Jesus invites us to come aside with him and gives us rest. His word satisfies every human longing, and his presence fills every human need. Everyone is welcome at his bountiful table, where they will find food for their souls and strength for their journey.

For Reflection: Do I recognize the needs of suffering people? Am I able to offer them the kindness that God has shown to me?

### Social Justice Committee News

Last week, we learned about a world-wide Catholic peace organization, Pax Christi International. Its members come from many countries around the world, including the United States. Pax Christi USA has their foundation in Catholic Social Teaching and the Gospel. They work to reject war, preparation for war, every form of violence and domination, and personal and systemic racism. They use a model of prayer, study and action to guide their work of advocating for disarmament, demilitarization, and reconciliation with justice, inclusiveness, economic and interracial justice, human rights and care for creation. You can find many educational materials and prayer resources, as well as join their movement on their website: paxchristiusa.org. The US Bishop's Conference monitors congressional legislation on peace issues and often sends letters to Congress to state the position of the church. Did you participate in the Chicken Run? Did you get a chance to take the Bottled Water taste test? The Social Justice Committee set up a table with 3 jugs of water: Dasani, Great Value brand and water from the tap. None of them were labeled. There were 59 participants in the test, who rated

which water they liked the best, with 6 people expressing "no preference". The winner of the taste test was the tap water!! 51% of the tasters chose it as their favorite. with 28% for the Dasani and 21% for the Great Value water. Why did we do this test? We want to encourage you to stop using bottled water! Purchase your own reusable water bottle, fill it with the good tasting water that comes out of your tap at home and take it with you. You will save money, and even more importantly, you will keep plastic pollution out of our waterways. It's a great way to care for creation. Try it!
