



#### THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

Jn 6:1-15

The prophet Elisha saw the hungry crowd and commanded



his servant to give the people something to eat. But the servant wondered how so many could be filled with such a scanty supply of grain. The prophet set aside these doubts and trusted in God's ability to provide. When the hungry people looked toward God with hope, God's hand opened with gifts for all.

Jesus looked with compassion on all who hungered for God's mercy. Although Jesus was fully able to supply their wants, he turned to his disciples to care for them. When they looked at their meager provisions, they felt hopeless in the face of so great a need. But Jesus saw abundance where they saw scarcity. In his hands there was always enough—and even more.

No matter how weak we think we are or how feeble our efforts seem to be, the Spirit makes it possible to live the super-abundant life we received in baptism. United as one body, we have the power to tend to the needs of all. When this happens, all people will acclaim: "This is God's prophet who has come into the world!"

For Reflection: What can I share for the good of others? Can I arouse hope in a hopeless world?

#### Social Justice Committee News

Many parishes throughout the country are working on local issues of peace. An example that could resonate in the Erie area comes from a Dallas parish. They have been working on issues of racial and economic justice to bring about peace. Working with other faith institutions in the area, they have built relationships with law enforcement to improve policing, including adding more officers and training them in de-escalation strategies. In addition, they are working to improve access to healthcare, end predatory payday loans and modify the local housing code to improve the unhealthy living environments in many low-income apartments. Locally, there is a peace group sponsored by the Benedictines. Among other things, they sponsor a monthly silent peace walk at various places around the Erie area. The walk is just 30 minutes but provides a time for silent prayer and solidarity for people who are encountering violent situations. Watch the bulletin for news of their next walk.
