



# This Sunday's <u>Reflection</u>



#### Mark 10:35-45

If we are honest, most of us would want others to serve us rather than our serving others. James and John didn't want to be lowly servants; they wanted positions of power and glory. It wasn't a polite, "May we, please?" but "We want you to grant our request." Jesus knew that they didn't understand what it meant to be his followers. Unbelievers may exercise authority by trying to "lord it over" others, but if they want to aspire to greatness, they must serve others as Jesus did. Being a disciple means radical self-denial and self-sacrifice, sharing the cup of Jesus's suffering and being immersed in his bath of pain.

Jesus doesn't stand aloof from our sinful nature. He knows what temptation is like. He is like the Jewish high Priest who entered the temple sanctuary to intercede for the sins of the people. Because Jesus sympathizes with our human weakness, we can confidently approach God, trusting in divine mercy whenever we are in need. The psalmist reminds us that God's "eyes" are on those who stand in awe of God's ways.
