THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION JOHN 20:19-31



Exiled for bearing witness to Jesus, John waited with patient endurance for God's reign to come. John experienced a vision of the risen Lord walking among the Christian community. With Christ's light, a beacon of hope was sent for all those living in fear. They need not be afraid; Jesus, the "one who lives," is eternally in our midst.

"Peace be with you," Jesus said to the disciples who were locked in their prison of fear. The breath of the Spirit animated them and revived their faith. Filled with the Spirit, they had the courage to declare: "We have seen the Lord." Thomas is our twin, doubting unless we can see for ourselves. "Touch my wounds," Jesus said to Thomas. To us he says: "Do not persist in unbelief. Believe!"

Day by day we are learning how to pray and worship together, how to love and forgive one another, how to exercise truth and justice, how to heal wounds and conquer evil. When the world sees these "signs and wonders," they will believe that Jesus is truly Lord of our lives.

For Reflection: Do you see signs of Christ among us? Can you still believe when you do not see them?
