



#### THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION JOHN 14:23-29



In every age and in every place, the church continues to renew itself. The struggle then as now is how to be faithful to the vision that was handed on in the past as we move ahead to the future. The early church was faced with this dilemma. As more gentiles came into the church, some Christians questioned whether those of another tradition should be burdened by Jewish religious practices. Paul and Barnabas did not make this decision alone. Along with the apostles and elders at Jerusalem they were guided by the Spirit, who continues to direct our judgements.

John of Patmos saw a vision of a New Jerusalem coming forth from the hand of God. The radiant, holy city was securely built on the foundation of Israel and the apostles. God the Almighty and the Lamb were their guiding light.

Jesus promised to dwell forever with those who lived in love and fidelity to his word. Jesus's followers should not to be distressed over his departure. They should be at peace because the Spirit would be sent as their advocate and helper. Just as Jesus led them in the past, the Spirit would continue to be in their midst to direct and teach them.

For Reflection: Am I confident of the Spirit's presence in my life? What evidence do I have?
