

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION Luke 9:11b-17



Our human hunger and thirst underline our spiritual hunger and thirst to be in communion with God. When we take the bread in our hands and the cup to our lips, it is not a memory but a living contact with Jesus Christ in faith and love. "Do this in remembrance of me," he commands to us. We "do this" not only when we break the bread and pour the wine but when we share our love with others. When we "do this," we have the assurance of our participation in God's reign.

When we refuse to share what we have received with the hungry and thirsty, the body is divided, and communion is not possible. "Why don't you feed them?" Jesus asks. We claim to have nothing, when in reality our hands are full. What we receive from the Lord we must hand on to others; then our offerings will be blessed and multiplied. At the table of the Lord, there is more than enough for all.

For Reflection: Do I recognize the Body and Blood of Christ in the sacrament? Do I also recognize his Body and Blood in my neighbor?
