

# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



JOHN 1:29-34

"A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me."

These words of John the Baptist seem like a riddle. Jesus was born after John but is older and ranks ahead of John. In human experience this doesn't make sense. We live by birth order. The older child or the oldest person comes first.

What seems like a simple riddle in reality announces a radical reordering of human existence. Jesus is clearly human and known to John's audience to have been born after John, so John's words mean that Jesus existed before John was born. How is this possible? Jesus is both human and divine. John is revealing that Jesus is the Son of God.

John is also hinting at the radical message that Jesus brings to human existence. The disruption of birth order implied when John says that Jesus "ranks ahead of me..." can be understood on two levels. We willingly rank Jesus ahead of ourselves as the Son of God. On another level Jesus' ministry will make clear that it is not priority of birth that matters but a new understanding of equality and service. We are all created equal in God's image and we are called to serve one another as equals.

For Reflection: In Ordinary Time, we contemplate things that are far form ordinary—things like existence of God, the person of Jesus and being made in God's image. Who in my life has witnessed to the greatness of God?

## **SOCIAL JUSTICE**

January opened with the annual celebration of the International World Day of Peace. During these days of the Season of Christmas, we rejoice that God took on our nature and entered our world as a vulnerable baby. Our hearts are gladdened by the laughter of children, their delight in the Christmas lights and Santa's surprises. But, the celebration of the International Day of Peace reminds us that for many of the world's children, pain, fear, hunger and trauma marks this season as it marks most of their days. As we begin 2020 with a commitment to work for peace in the world, let the cries of the children inspire us to action.

On the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of UNICEF, the United Nations published a report which chronicled the toll of war on children in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The decade that brought that century to a close saw the following impact of war on the most vulnerable members of the human race, our children.

- •2 million killed;
- •4-5 million disabled;
- •12 million left homeless; more than 1 million orphaned or separated from their parents;
- •some 10 million psychologically traumatized."

The most recent report of the World Food Program reveals a close link between armed conflict and hunger. More than 56 million people faced starvation in 2018, the vast majority of these were living in nations at war.

As hunger and conflict fuel one another, the recent proliferation of conflicts has reversed several decades of progress fighting global hunger. Today, people living in conflict-stricken areas make up 60 percent of the world's 815 million chronically hungry. They are more than twice as likely to be undernourished than those living in countries at peace.
