



THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



MATTHEW 17:1-9

"...His face shone like the sun..."

In Matthew's Gospel the transfiguration is sandwiched between two predictions of Jesus' suffering. In our lives, too, the shining moments come right in the midst of the messiness of our lives. The story of the Transfiguration is reminiscent of Jesus' baptism. A voice from the heavens heralds Jesus as the Beloved to whom we should listen.

As we drag these limited human bodies around with us it is easy to forget that we are temples of God. We believe the Spirit of Jesus dwells in us, yet the shining glory isn't visible on most days. We must practice listening for the heavenly voice that comes to us from the small openings in the clouds of daily life.

When Jesus cautions his disciples about announcing the vision, perhaps he is aware of the danger of sensationalism. People will flock in droves to places where some special miracle took place. Yet the little miracles that surround us every day often go unnoticed.

What are your Tabor moments? Where is the shining in your life? If you become attentive to the glory you carry in your earthenware temple you will never again be tempted to drag it around like a burden

Reflection: Have I experienced any moments of transfiguration? How have these moments changed me?


Women's History Month

The Nineteenth Amendment is 101 years old, yet many issues still impede the progress of women in our society. Women's wages still lag behind those of men: \$.79 for each dollar men made in 2019. The USA ranks last in government-mandated paid leave for new parents among developed countries. Pope Francis cautions that women must be "must be protected and helped in... the right to work and the right to motherhood. The challenge is to protect their right to a job that is given full recognition while at the same time safeguarding their vocation to motherhood and their presence in the family."
