



THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



MATTHEW 13:44-52

"The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field"

The parables of the treasure in the field and of the merchant searching for fine pearls seem very similar, but they describe different ways the kingdom of heaven enters our lives. The person discovering the treasure was not looking for it. It was a surprise, and required alertness to recognize its value. The merchant knew what he was looking for to begin with. Both, however, sacrificed everything for what they found.

The kingdom breaks into our lives in large and small ways. It may be a life vocation, or it may be a need that briefly crosses our path, or a person who brightens our day. Whether the event becomes a share of the kingdom does not depend on the richness of the treasure or the size of the pearl, but the response of the heart.

Others may have discovered the treasure or the pearl before the people in Jesus' story came along, but either they did not recognize their value or had been unwilling to sacrifice for them. The parables call us to be alert every day for the surprise of the kingdom of heaven and, when it appears, to pursue it with all of our heart.

Reflection: How can I remain alert in the coming week to the surprises God has in store for me? Will I be able to recognize the signs of the kingdom?
