

# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION MATTHEW 14:22-33



"Do not be afraid."

Someone once told me, or perhaps I read somewhere, that the words "Do not be afraid," or "Fear not," are repeated 365 times in the Scriptures one for every day of the year. While I have never counted, I like to believe that God wishes us freedom from fear and worry so much that he reassures us again and again.

Fear is a powerful emotion. Fear causes physical symptoms - increased blood pressure and heart rate, sweating, shallowness of breath. We experience a rush of adrenaline and stand poised ready for "flight" or "fight." Doctors tell us that the stress of prolonged fear can severely damage our bodies.

Sometimes we experience mental confusion. We cannot think or reason clearly. We do not recognize the solution to our problem, even when it is right in front of us.

That was the reaction of the disciples when they were caught in the unanticipated storm. As fishermen, they were at home on the lake. Yet a sudden change in the wind left them crouched in fear. They were so confused they did not recognize Jesus when he came to their rescue.

In times of crisis, Jesus is with us. "Do not be afraid," he tells us. "It is I."

Reflection: What kinds of fears have I been willing to surrender to God? What fears do I hold on to and how can I begin to release them to God?

# FAITH & RACIAL HEALING Embracing Truth, Justice & Healing

An Opportunity To Reflect As A Community On Race In America From The Perspective Of Our Faith

In the past few weeks, the issue of racial inequality has become a topic of conversation, news articles and debate. We have heard from people in positions of power and people walking on the streets. Our Christian tradition has also been talking about racial equality for quite some time. It is essential that we listen to the voice of our faith as we discern our response to this pressing social issue. In "Faith & Racial Healing", participants will look at the history of race in the U.S. through the Christian lens. Each session will focus on a different era or issue in our racial history. This enrichment opportunity will be conducted via Zoom. Participants will gather for prayer and conversation, discussion of books and videos, reflection on society and on our own hearts as we journey toward reconciliation with God and our neighbor.


