



Parish Mission

The title of "Our Lady of Mercy" is almost 900 years old. Tradition holds that around the year 1218 AD, both St. Peter Nolasco and King James I of Aragon and Catalonia experienced separate apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary requesting them to establish a religious order entrusted with the responsibility of rescuing the many Christians who were being held captive by the Moorish armies who invaded the Iberian peninsula.

In 1235 AD, the Order of Our Lady of Mercy received papal approval by Pope Gregory IX, and succeeded in liberating thousands of Christian prisoners from captivity. The Order was later able to shift its mission toward education and social work.



Today, the Virgin Mother is honored under the title of "Our Lady of Mercy" throughout the world by countless parishes, schools and hospitals who embrace her as their Patroness.

Are you registered to vote? Oct. 19, 2020 is the last day to register to vote before the election on Nov. 3, 2020.


<u>Do you want to use a mail-in ballot?</u> To qualify for a mail-in ballot you must be registered to vote in Erie County and your completed application for the mail-in ballot form must be received in the county office by 5:00 PM on Oct. 27. You may obtain a mail in ballot by applying for one online, submitting a form via the US Mail, or by visiting certain locations in Erie County.

●To obtain instructions visit <u>www.eriecountypa.gov</u> and click on the green <u>button</u> to the right of this image:



•Next click on "Registration and Voting" drop down arrow in the gray box on the right hand side of the page and then click on "Mail-in and Absentee Ballots."

You will find instructions to guide you through obtaining a mail-in ballot.



Returning your mail-in ballot

In Erie County, there are three methods by which you may submit your mail-in ballot.

- •Mail your ballot using the provided postage paid envelope. Be sure to complete the Voters declaration.
- •Use the secure drop box, located in front of the Erie County Courthouse. The drop box is available 24/7. Be sure to complete the Voters declaration.
- Hand deliver your ballot to the Voters Registration office. Be sure to complete the Voters declaration.

The deadline for the Erie County Board of Elections to receive your voted ballot is 8:00 pm on Election Day. (The state Supreme Court ruled on Sept. 17, 2020 that election officials should count ballots that are received as late as Nov. 6, as long as they are postmarked by Nov. 3. Ballots that arrive by the new deadline with missing or illegible postmarks will be counted.) Once your ballot has been received, you may not vote at your poll site.

If you applied for a ballot, but you have not received it, you may vote a provisional ballot at your poll. If you received your ballot, but do not have enough time to mail it back to the Board of Elections by the deadline, you may:

- Hand deliver it to the Voter Registration office
- Use the drop box
- •Surrender all of your balloting materials at your poll site to be voided by the Judge of Elections, and cast your vote at the poll.
