



## THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



**MATTHEW 2:1-12** 

"Go and search diligently for the child."

King Herod's search for the "newborn king of the Jews" fills readers with dread; we know the plans Herod has for this child who might someday threaten his power. And yet Herod's words contain great wisdom. We too are called to make a diligent search for Jesus.

Diligence is characterized by a steady effort, an unwavering spirit, and an ability to focus on the object of our desire. It's not that Jesus is so hard to find - he's right in our midst. That's the lesson of the Incarnation. Diligence is needed because we can so easily be distracted and lose our way.

When we search diligently for the child Jesus, we discover at the same time the immensity of God's loving desire to be one with us. We encounter not only a babe in swaddling clothes, but in the manger we find all the hopes and dreams of humanity and we are invited to bow low in awe - in awe of what Jesus reveals to us about God and in awe of what Jesus reveals to us about our own human nature.

Like the Magi who are filled with anticipation, our search is one of longing. Like the Magi, our search will lead to joy.

For Reflection: When has my search for Jesus let me to a greater realization of God's own desires for my life?

### **Help for Heating - LIHEAP**




The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) was open to help alleviate heating bill stress on low income families. A family of four with a gross annual

But too often, we are unaware of their situation because they suffer in silence. Lori Palisin will help us understand the many forms domestic violence takes, the signs by which we can recognize domestic violence and the ways we can help those we encounter who are struggling. Lori Palisin has served victims of domestic violence for 24 years, providing resources, support, advocacy and education.



## Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments

January is Human Trafficking Prevention Month Who are the perpetrators? Traffickers can be anyone who profits from the selling of a child for sex to a buyer, including family members, foster parents, friends, gangs, trusted adults, or "boyfriends." Much of the trafficking of children has moved from street corners and truck stops to the internet where children are sold for sex. Online classified sites allow traffickers and buyers anonymity and accessibility when exploiting children. In some case, there is no identified trafficker, and it is the person buying sex from the child who is exploiting the child's vulnerabilities. A child cannot consent to being bought and sold for sex, and anyone purchasing sex from a child is committing a serious crime. If you suspect a case of Child Sex Trafficking you can call 1-800-THE-LOST or make a report at www.CyberTipline.org.


