

Whether I am disappointed with myself or it is a hurt that involves another person this notion of forgiving and forgetting just does not work. At least that's the way it seems. I realized, much later in life, that forgiveness is a process.

I thought the meaning of Mt 18:22 when Jesus tells Peter he must forgive seventy times seven times (limitless) was that there is always something to forgive. Experience teaches that I must forgive the same thing seventy times seven times. The mistake I made or the hurt I experienced keeps coming into my mind and I must forgive again.

Each time I forgive that same thing, it hurts a little less, and at some point, it really is forgotten. Or if I do remember the event, it no longer carries the emotion to upset me.

It can take a while, but that is one meaning of process.

Most of us do not know when the hour of our death will come, or if it will be filled with pain. As Jesus approached his death, he was aware that it would involve much suffering, but that by his suffering and death God would be glorified.

My father died several years ago, and I sat by his side as he took his last breath. It was a peaceful death. The preceding years had required that my sisters and I spend time with him and my mother each day, helping with their needs. This was a real hardship as well as a real blessing.

During this time I got to know much more about my father and what he valued in life. He loved his wife through their 67 years of marriage and put her needs before his, especially in the years before his death, caring for her physical needs at the expense of his own health. He must have died to self many times through the years in choosing to love her and provide for his family. A faithful Christian, he follow in the steps of Jesus from his baptism to his death.

His life glorified God.
