

# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

**LUKE 24:35-48** 

"THEY WERE STARTLED AND TERRIFIED AND THOUGHT THAT THEY WERE SEEING A GHOST."



As our parish celebrated Easter, a child asked, "How is Jesus with us today? Is he here like a ghost?" The disciples asked the same question on the first Easter day. Jesus responded by inviting them to look at his wounds, touch him, and give him something to eat. He wanted them to be sure that he was not a ghost.

Have you ever wished that you could have been there to share that gift of physical contact with the body of the Risen Lord? Jesus has given us a greater gift, the gift of the Spirit, a gift the disciples had not yet received. Their capacity to experience Jesus was limited to their senses and the powers of their minds to understand. The Spirit would enable them and us to move beyond that time and place to encounter Jesus in all of the ways he promised.

We can understand the Scriptures, experience the forgiveness of sins, know him in the Eucharist, and find him in his witnesses. We are called to be his witnesses. Our Lord is not a ghostly being. He is with us and we can encounter him in ways that transform us.

For Reflection: In what ways do I encounter Jesus in the normal routine of my life? Can I sense the Spirit's presence?
