MISSION STATEMENT



THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION MARK 4:35-41 "JESUS WAS IN THE STERN, ASLEEP ON A CUSHION."



One night last November a 97-year-old woman was on her deathbed with her family gathered around. She had been a woman of faith and prayer all her life. She asked, "what is that light?" They thought she meant the light at the head of her bed. "No, that one over there by the door." They turned off the light. The room was dark. "Is the light still there, Mother?" "Yes." "Does it bother you?" She smiled: "No, not at all." Not many hours later, she died.

Unlike the dying woman who found peace I what might have been frightening, the disciples were terrified because of a wild sea. They were shocked and angry that Jesus slept peacefully in the midst of it all. "Do you not care that we are perishing?" But he had a different question: "Do you not yet have faith?"

Jesus was confident that his Father was with him at all times, and even in extreme danger, he knew that the Father's eyes were looking on him with love. Whatever might happen, even death, that light would not go out.

For Reflection: Where do I need faith to see the light in the darkness or the calm beyond the stormy sea?
