

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

MARK 5:21-43

"FEAR IS USELESS;

WHAT IS NEEDED IS FAITH."



Mark depicts Jesus as a human being with unaffected, natural reactions to human encounters. When the woman with the hemorrhage touches Jesus, he quickly turns around, naturally wanting to see who touched him. To Jairus, Jesus reacts with sympathy, responding at once to his plea.

Mark uses two characters to hammer home his message: "Fear is useless; what is needed is faith." The woman who approaches Jesus has already tried everything else. And yet, keeping hope alive, she reaches out in faith to touch Jesus. Jairus takes a big risk to approach Jesus. Jairus held a high position at the synagogue, where traditions was the rule. Andy yet, risking his position, he reaches out in faith to ask Jesus to heal his daughter. In both cases, faith is rewarded; Jesus heals the physical ailments of both the woman and Jairus' young daughter.

Many of us find fear and worry to be unwelcome companions. This Gospel tells us that Jesus' human nature would understand. Mark has shown us that Jesus truly cares about what concerns and frightens us. Mark would urge us to take a risk today - of placing even one of our fears into the human, sympathetic, and compassionate hands of Jesus.

For Reflection: Which fear will you place in Jesus' hands today?


