THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION MARK 6:7-13



Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two, and gave them authority over unclean spirits. He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick - no food, no sack, no money in their belts.

One day two Mormon missionaries knocked on my door. We talked briefly and then I identified myself as a missionary priest. One of them told me that he was nearing the end of a two-year experience in mission in Arkansas. I asked him what he would remember from his experience of having left home and loved ones. He said to me, "I will never forget who I am. I am a missionary."

That stuck with me. Whether I am at home or far away, my call is to be a messenger of Good News. A basic, fundamental aspect of discipleship is that we are called and sent out. A missionary is a believer who shares in the life and mission of Jesus.

Jesus strictly commands his disciples to travel light. This makes the source of their authority and power most apparent - it is God who has the power to change hearts, who has authority over evil, and who heals and forgives. God has us to put the flesh and bones on the Good News.

For Reflection: Am I a messenger of the Good News? Who are people of witness that strengthen my faith?


