

REFLECTION ON THE TRANSFIGURATION



MARK 9:2-10

Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Rabbi, it is good that we are here!"

We have probably all had time sin our lives when things were so good, so peaceful, that we wanted to freeze time and stay right in the moment. We might recall special times like this - a childhood memory, perhaps a marriage, or the birth of a child or grandchild.

Maybe like Peter, James, and John we have had a mountaintop experience of God in our life. We want to sustain the wonder and joy of these times, "to make tents," but we cannot stay in these moments. We need these times to strengthen us just as the disciples did, but to plant our feet immovably in a single experience of God would be to deny ourselves the rest of the journey God requires of us.

Jesus came down the mountain because he knew that his journey was not over. We may doubt, hesitate, and even fear, but we continue our journey knowing that Jesus promised to be with us all our days. Our Father's words, "This is my beloved Son, listen to him," are for us. We have only to listen and take the next step.

For Reflection: What "mountaintop" experiences continue to sustain me when I feel weary or afraid? How could these experiences strengthen me in my continuing spiritual journey?

Documentation for Safety

Working alongside the Bishop, the Office for the Protection of Children and Youth reinforces the ongoing implementation of policies and procedures that protect children. The diocesan Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth screening guidelines and abuse prevention training programs emphasize the importance of knowing the employees and volunteers who have access to children in our schools and parishes. Parents should remain vigilant in insisting that those with access to their children have gone through an application process and obtained the required clearances and trainings before being granted access to their children.
