



THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

JOHN 6:51-58

"I am the living bread...whoever eats this bread will live forever."

It seems to me that the way we approach and receive the Eucharist speaks volumes about its meaning for us in our lives. There is real sign value here!

Another action that speaks volumes is how we act once we have received and eaten this bread.

Imagine a non-believer coming into our church for the first time and seeing people quietly and reverently lining up to receive a small piece of bread and a sip of wine. This bread is living bread - true food and drink. It is bread that nourishes and changes us so that we become what we eat. We become Eucharist for others.

The story is told of a catechist who was meeting with an adult preparing for the sacrament of the Eucharist. The catechist was explaining our belief that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist. The man he was instructing seemed confused and when the catechist asked what he did not understand, the man replied, "If you really believed that Jesus was present in the bread, wouldn't you be more living and respectful toward each other?"

For Reflection: How is my life being transformed each time I receive the Eucharist? Is there evidence that others can see?


Rosary March

Do you have some picture of the old church or pictures of when the community met at the Boy's Home? What about pictures of various parish activities and events that



The OLM Youth Ministry Core Team is a group of adults that gathers every month to plan and implement ways to connect the youth of our community with the world wide Church




