




THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

MARK 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

"This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me"



There is a television show entitled "Keeping Up Appearances." It is a satire. Yet many people identify with the characters because we realize that sometime we are more concerned about what others think of us than how we truly are before God. We pay great attention to behaviors and customs that are popular and accepted instead of acting on principles and conviction.

This tendency leads us even to be "funny" in our prayer life and in our relationship with God. We may go to church and we may wear a medal or cross because it is fashionable. We say certain prayers and practice some devotions because our friends do that. There is no knowledge of the meaning and importance of that practice, but everyone does it.

We see the outside, God sees the inside. Our thoughts and our words reveal what is in our hearts: "The things that come out from within are what defile" (7:16). Honesty and gratitude are beautiful characteristics of a person that speaks from the heart and not simply utters sayings that may seem proper but are not sincere. "It is only with the heart that one can see rightly; what is essential is invisible to the eye," said the fox to the Little Prince. That is what really counts.

For Reflection: Has my concern for appearances clouded my commitment to God's ways?
