THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

MARK 8:27-35

...the Son of Man must suffer greatly.

This Gospel speaks to me about vulnerability - about the way Jesus preached it and the way we reject it.

Jesus asks his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter answers, "You are the Messiah." Peter's answer sounds right. But Jesus knows that Peter wants the Messiah to be strong and powerful enough to free the Hebrew people from the Romans and lead the Jews to their destiny. Jesus himself understand his role quite differently. He knows his destiny as Messiah holds rejection, suffering, and death.

After this scene, there is a turning point in Mark's Gospel. From now on, Jesus will be trying to make the disciples (and us) understand that not only will he suffer and die, but that anyone who wants to be a true follower will have to do the same.

Another question, "What kind of Messiah will Jesus be?" has now been answered. As Messiah, Jesus will accept his Father's will, becoming vulnerable and completely powerless at the end.

The more we can stand to be vulnerable and powerless in life, the better we will be ready to step across to death. Maybe vulnerability is the "cross" that Jesus, the Messiah, is asking us to bear.

For Reflection: Can I allow myself to be vulnerable? What might I gain by letting go of the need to control?
