

# REFLECTION

**MARK 10:35-45** 

"Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant."



"Be careful what you wish for" is a fitting lesson for these sons of Zebedee. They discover that in the kingdom Jesus establishes, their wish for power will not lead to honor and glory. True greatness is manifest in service.

The Son of God himself was a model of service - coming not to be served but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many (Mark 10:45), identifying himself as one who serves at table (Luke 22:27), and washing the dirty feet of his followers (John 13:1-20). Followers of Jesus are to be shaped in his image.

True greatness, then, is found in feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, welcoming the stranger, clothing the naked, caring for the ill, and visiting the imprisoned (see Matt 25:31-46). Do we wish for these opportunities in our heart of hearts? Are we prepared to feed and welcome and clothe those who may never find a voice for themselves in our halls of power? Those with whom "rubbing elbows" would bring no prestige?

In the midst of the church's "ordinary time" we are asked to see greatness in ordinary people and ordinary actions.

For Reflection: What is my deepest desire? Can I ask God to continue transforming me and my desires?

# Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments



**Bullying Prevention Month** 

Cyberbullying is bullying that takes place over digital devices like cell phones, computers, and tablets. Cyberbullying can occur through SMS, Text, and apps, or online in social media, forums, or gaming where people can view, participate in, or share content. Cyberbullying includes sending, posting, or sharing negative, harmful, false, or mean content about someone else. It can include sharing personal or private information about someone else causing embarrassment or humiliation. Some cyberbullying crosses the line into unlawful or criminal behavior. The most common places where cyberbullying occurs are: Social Media, such as Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, and Tik Tok; Text messaging and messaging apps on mobile or tablet devices; Instant messaging, direct messaging, and online chatting over the internet; Online forums, chat rooms, and message boards, such as Reddit; Email; and online gaming communities. Adults should take the same approach to address it: support the child being bullied, address the bullying behavior of a participant, and show children that cyberbullying is taken seriously. 
