






# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

**MARK 12:28-34** 

"...with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength."



According to the great commandment this is how I am to love God. The **all** frightens me. **All** is everything I have; nothing is held back. How am I to love One I cannot see with my physical eyes, in such a total manner?

As I struggle to believe in my ability to love God so completely the second commandment comes to my assistance. I am to love my neighbor as myself. Here I receive a clue as to how to love this unseen God and it has something to do with my neighbor. Another scriptural text sounds in my ear, "those who do not love a brother [or sister] whom they have seen, cannot love God whom they have not seen" (1 John 4:20).

Jesus speaks of a love that has infinite power. The way to let God rule my life is to give myself to that love. My **all** today is not the same as my **all** tomorrow. I am to love with as much heart and soul as I have at the present moment.

# **Social Justice**


"Life is this simple: We are living in a world that is absolutely transparent and God is shining through it all the time. This is not




