




THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 4:21-30

"...no prophet is accepted in his own native place."



All of us are proud of our heritage, but we must question, on occasion, just how far to carry this pride. Do we use it to exclude others from our circle of acquaintances because of skin color, ancestry or religious tradition? Jesus confronted this issue with a group in the synagogue in today's narrative.

The Israelites were the chosen people of God. To many Jews this was the core belief of their tradition. Any rewards in this life or the next were reserved to them, to the exclusion of all others. This appears in total disregard to the teaching of the prophets or the writer of many of the Psalms. God had opened the kingdom to all nations, but many of the Jewish faith tradition would have no part of it.

When Jesus, a hometown boy, spoke the truth, it was a message the listeners didn't want to hear form this young rabbi. There could be a simple solution - kill the messenger, as had been done to many prophets.

As he did at the end of his earthly life, Jesus passed through death. "He passed through the midst of them."

For Reflection: When I participate in liturgy, how am I open to the message being preached? Is it possible to change preconceived notions regarding the message or the messenger?





