



THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 5:1-11

Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid."



In today's Gospel, the disciples are caught up with the ordinary circumstances of their trade. As the old saying goes, the fishing has been good, but the catching not so. After laboring throughout the darkness of the night, they find their nets empty and themselves disappointed and frustrated.

Jesus, interested in a different catch, calls to Simon and tells him to cast out the nets into the deep. Simon is reluctant. Does he now doubt his own abilities? Or does he feel that Jesus does not understand his struggles? Simon's apparent failure does not keep Jesus from going deeper. Nor does it keep Simon from taking a chance and doing as Jesus commands.

Miraculously the nets are full. God makes something great out of nothing. Simon is filled with awe at the sight of the power of God. Jesus' words to him are very important, "do not be afraid." Now Simon knows deep in his heart that where the Lord leads him, he has to follow.

Can what the world calls "weakness" be where God works wonders in our lives? Mediate on the phrase, "the Almighty has done great things for me..."

For Reflection: Does my apparent inadequacy or fear of failure keep me from following the Lord?


Our Neighbors' Place Update
