# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 13:1-9

"Do you think they were more guilty?"



Jesus asks his listeners to consider the fate of those who recently died, some in a senseless slaughter, others in a tragic accident. One was an act of government-sponsored terrorism, in the other, a building collapsed. Were the victims somehow responsible? Had their sins caught up with them?

Today we sometimes hear of an irresponsible figure claiming that a devastating earthquake or storm was punishment from God. Jesus rejects the notion. But he does warn us all: disaster could overtake any one of us. Have we turned our lives over to God?

Jesus then tells a parable about a patient laborer, a gardener, that will wait even a fourth year for a fig tree to bear fruit, despite the owner having run out of patience. When we look for the hand of God in human affairs, do we look for signs of judgement, or signs of mercy? Jesus seems to be telling us that God is the one who comes to forestall judgement, to call for mercy, to urge reconciliation.

Too often we look for God in the conclusion of matters, when God is striving to change our course while we are still in the middle of the matter.

Reflection: Have I been patient enough with myself or others?

Our Lady of Mercy Parish is seeking a director of music





