

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



JOHN 20:19-31

These are written that you may come to believe. Thomas is not the only apostle to have doubted. Matthew tells us that all eleven doubted, even as they gathered around the risen Christ and worshiped (Mt 28:17).

Easter brings us Good News beyond comprehension. It wasn't enough to be there to believe it. Even seeing wasn't believing. Thomas could doubt his eye, he wanted to touch and feel. Maybe that would make it seem more real. But John the Evangelist knows what finally clinches their faith. Having been given Jesus' gift of the Spriit, when they hear his words, the Spirit will respond in their own hearts: This is he; this si the Christ, risen from the dead! We believe because of the words he speaks are the words of the Spirit and life (Jn 6:63).

And that is where we too will have our faith affirmed. Are there doubts that sometimes trouble you? How like the apostles you are! Open the gospels and read. They are written that you might believe.

BABY BOTTLE FUNDRAISER Our Knights of Columbus council has

joined all the other councils in Erie and Crawford Counties to conduct a Baby Bottle fundraising drive to benefit the Women's Care Center of Erie with a goal of purchasing a mobile ultrasound van. This medically equipped vehicle will visit rural areas, as well as our five local universities to provide valuable lifesaving services. In 2021, our OLM and St. Gregory's K of C councils partnered to provide an ultrasound machine to the Care Center, and in less than a year 63 previously abortion bound women chose life for their unborn children, after viewing them on this state of the art machine. While this is certainly an achievement, we are now focusing on helping to raise \$250,000 to purchase a mobile ultrasound van. If the K of C along with other entities is able to achieve this goal, the K of C Supreme council in Connecticut will pay the entire cost of the mobile ultrasound machine, amounting to about \$50,000. Baby bottles will be distributed as you leave church on Mother's Day. If you are financially able, we ask that you fill them with change, currency or checks and return them on Father's Day. All proceeds will go to the purchase of the mobile ultrasound van.
