

# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION JOHN 10:27-30



"My sheep hear my voice."

My wife tells a story about our son during his first semester of college at a school 1,200 miles away. He called home one morning, very tired, down with a bad cold, and feeling homesick. "He knew there was nothing I could do for him," she says, "but he wanted to hear my voice."

Today's Gospel is brief, but not simple. In a few short lines, Jesus addresses our longing for belonging, promises eternal life, describes the power of God, and confounds us with the statement, "The Father and I are one." Wow! There is a lot going on here. But it begins with hearing.

Hearing can mean both receiving sound and understanding sound. We cannot fully understand the power of God, or the mystery of God, or the nature of eternal life. But we can understand the voice of Jesus in the same way that sheep hear the voice of their shepherd, or a child hears his mother's voice. We feel comfort and protection and a sense of belonging.

Reflection: Do I recognize the voice of Jesus? Am I prepared to listen?


### **Grief Support Group**

#### **Summer Scripture Study**

Have you ever wondered how the parables of Jesus would have been heard and understood by the Jewish



audience who listened to Jesus in real time? The Prodigal Son, The Good Samaritan, The Lost Sheep, these stories are as familiar as our own names. They have been explained to us from childhood. We know what they mean. But do we know what they meant? In our Summer Scripture Study, we will try to hear these stories with the ears of a first century Palestinian Jew. Our study guide will be "Short Stories by Jesus: Enigmatic Parables of a Controversial Rabbi" the Study Guide by Amy-Jill Levine. #### **BABY BOTTLE FUNDRAISER**

Our Knights of Columbus council has joined all the other councils in Erie and Crawford Counties to conduct a Baby Bottle fundraising drive to benefit the Women's Care Center of Erie with a goal of purchasing a mobile ultrasound van. This medically equipped vehicle will visit rural areas, as well as our five local universities to provide valuable lifesaving services. In 2021, our OLM and St. Gregory's K of C councils partnered to provide an ultrasound machine to the Care Center, and in less than a year 63 previously abortion bound women chose life for their unborn children, after viewing them on this state of the art machine. While this is certainly an achievement, we are now focusing on helping to raise \$250,000 to purchase a mobile ultrasound van. If the K of C along with other entities is able to achieve this goal, the K of C Supreme council in Connecticut will pay the entire cost of the mobile ultrasound machine, amounting to about \$50,000. Baby bottles will be distributed as you leave church on Mother's Day. If you are financially able, we ask that you fill them with change, currency or checks and return them on Father's Day. All proceeds will go to the purchase of the mobile ultrasound van.

# Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments

## **Bullying**

The Centers for Disease Control and Department of Education define bullying as: any unwanted aggressive behavior(s) by another youth or group of youths, who are not siblings or current dating partners, that involves an observed or perceived power imbalance and is repeated multiple times or is highly likely to be repeated. 20% of students ages 12-18 experienced bullving nationwide. 19% of students in grades 9-12 report being bullied on school property. When adults respond quickly to bullying behavior, they send the message that it is not acceptable. There are ways parents can make a positive difference. Parents should educate themselves on the signs that a child has been bullied or is a bully. They should keep the lines of communication open with their child and model for their child how to treat others. Parents can encourage their child to be inclusive by welcoming others to join their activities and groups. 
