



## THIS REFLECTION



JOHN 13:31-35

"As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."

What do these things have in common: disciplining a disobedient child, donating a kidney to your sister, taking the keys away from an inebriated friend? They are all acts of the kind of love with which Jesus has loved us.

The word "love" is used in so many ways in our society, from the sublime (love of God) to the ridiculous (love of puns), that it is difficult to know in some cases exactly what is meant to be conveyed by the word.

With gospel love, the issue is simple: love means to want what is best for the other and do the best that you can for the other. It is primarily a decision, not a feeling, though feelings from the heart may accompany decisions of love. But if there is no decision about what is best for the other, it is not love, no matter how good it feels or what it is called.

Jesus wanted what is best for us so much that the did the ultimate toward bringing it about, giving his life for our salvation. "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."

Reflection: In what ways has Jesus' love for me equipped me to want the best for those I encounter in life?

### Housing Help




Guided by the Holy Spirit, our search for a pastoral music minister for Our Lady of Mercy continues. We have received an application and we will interview

We know what they mean. But do we know what they meant? In our Summer Scripture Study, we will try to hear these stories with the ears of a first century Palestinian Jew. 
#### **NEED A SUMMER JOB?**

#### **BABY BOTTLE FUNDRAISER**

Our Knights of Columbus council has joined all the other councils in Erie and Crawford Counties to conduct a Baby Bottle fundraising drive to benefit the Women's Care Center of Erie with a goal of purchasing a mobile ultrasound van. This medically equipped vehicle will visit rural areas, as well as our five local universities to provide valuable lifesaving services. In 2021, our OLM and St. Gregory's K of C councils partnered to provide an ultrasound machine to the Care Center, and in less than a year 63 previously abortion bound women chose life for their unborn children, after viewing them on this state of the art machine. While this is certainly an achievement, we are now focusing on helping to raise \$250,000 to purchase a mobile ultrasound van. If the K of C along with other entities is able to achieve this goal, the K of C Supreme council in Connecticut will pay the entire cost of the mobile ultrasound machine, amounting to about \$50,000. Baby bottles will be distributed as you leave church on Mother's Day. If you are financially able, we ask that you fill them with change, currency or checks and return them on Father's Day. All proceeds will go to the purchase of the mobile ultrasound van.
