



# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

JOHN 14:23-29

"The Holy Spirit...will teach you everything."



It has been my privilege over many years to be part of a catechumenate team that works with adults who are discerning how God is calling them. We are always challenged by the depth of their questions and the intensity of their seeking a more intimate relationship with Jesus. Each year as we approach Easter I feel a bit apprehensive. Have we been able to give these new friends in the faith enough formation opportunities? Will they know how to live discipleship and be able to stand firm in their faith?

Perhaps Jesus is feeling the same way in today's gospel as he reminds the apostles, "whoever loves me will keep my word and my Father will love him." He prepares them to receive the Holy Spirit who will teach them and remind them of what they have already learned by being close to Jesus. Rejoice, he reminds them. He is leaving because the Holy Spirit can produce from their stumbling efforts a rich harvest for the Father.

This same advocate guides us today. We can experience the same peace that is promised in the gospel. Just as Jesus let go of the disciples and entrusted them to the Advocate we also trust that the same Advocate will be with us.

Reflection: How does the Holy Spirit continue to instruct me and strengthen me in my faith?

audience who listened to Jesus in real time? The Prodigal Son, The Good Samaritan, The Lost Sheep, these stories are as familiar as our own names. They have been explained to us from childhood. We know what they mean. But do we know what they meant. In our Summer Scripture Study, we will try to hear these stories with the ears of a first century Palestinian Jew. Our study guide will be "Short Stories by Jesus: Enigmatic Parables of a Controversial Rabbi" the Study Guide by Amy-Jill Levine.
