



THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION



LUKE 11:1-13

"He will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence."

Padre, Padre you give us quite a scare. You're going in for surgery and we're holding you in prayer


The doctors and nurses they've got your care Clippety clop, clippety clop they'll do a good repair
