



This Sunday's Reflection



LUKE 12:13-21

"I shall tear down my barns and build larger ones."
In Jesus' parable, enough was not enough. The rich man already had not one barn, but multiple barns. He was already rich and held enough land that its normal produce filled more than one barn.

Then he was given an unusually bountiful harvest. He woke up one morning and had the multi-million-dollar lottery ticket. And his first thought was not what good he could do with such bounty. It was to tear down what he had and make room for even more - all for himself.

God would call him that night with the words, "You fool."

From Psalm 14, we know the Jewish audience understood: "The fool says in his heart, "there is no God." In the Jewish tradition, the fool was the opposite of the wise and faithful. In fact, the fool was not merely witless, he was ethically reprehensible. He insulted the devout; he insulted God himself. In the final analysis, the rich man as fool is an atheist.

"Thus will it be for all who store up treasures for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God."

For Reflection: In what ways do I use my treasure? In what ways does my treasure "use" me?

Our Lady of Mercy has hired a music director, Linda Peters, who auditioned with us last year and has played for some of our Saturday 6pm masses. Linda will begin



In Loving Memory of Fr. Ritchie




Catechist Needed


