





THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 32-48

"Be prepared."



Recently I was out with my youngest daughter who is a new driver. She was behind the wheel and doing a good job. Suddenly another car ran a stop sign and was right in front of us. I quickly reached across and turned the steering wheel, barely avoiding hitting the other car. My daughter was totally shocked about what just happened and was visibly shaken. I explained to her that just because she drives safely it doesn't mean others always do. I pointed out that she constantly needs to be watching and preparing for some unforeseen event because we don't know when we will need to be ready.

In our Gospel today Jesus reminds us of the same thing. He tells us that we need to be watchful and we need to be prepared. He tells us about the slaves who were ready for their master's return. He says, these slaves will be blessed. Then Jesus tells another parable about another set of slaves who aren't ready when their master returns. He says these slaves will be put with the unfaithful. Jesus is giving us a warning that new need to be prepared because we know not when our Master will return for us.



There are memories that beg to be shared.


