





THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 13:22-30

"Lord, will only a few people be saved?"

What feeling came over you when you read today's Gospel? Did you feel scared - or smug?



The story describes a long day at the doctor's office, where Mrs. Turpin encounters someone from almost every one of her "classes." It's too much for her. When she finally gets home, she experiences a powerful vision while standing by her (very clean) hog pen. She sees a vast swinging bridge carrying a procession of souls "rumbling toward heaven." At the front, dressed in white and shouting hallelujah? All the "classes" Mrs. Turpin has railed against all her life. And at the rear, with shocked faces? "Her people" - those who, like herself,..."had always had a little of everything and the God-given wit to use it right."

Thank you, Flannery O'Connor, for Mrs. Turpin, and for explaining the words of Jesus. Until we see ourselves clearly, we aren't ready to recline at the table in the Kingdom of God.


Ink Jet Fundraiser

Open our eyes to the present, enable us to see your vision for our future; showing us the way to go.


Give us the wisdom to wait for you as we trust you to teach us and guide us.
