






# THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

**LUKE 14:1, 7-14** 

"Everyone who exalts himself shall be humbled but the one who humbles himself will be exalted."



Humility was not a virtue among this crowd as evidenced by their jockeying for places of honor. Who better than Jesus to make a point regarding the value of putting others first and oneself last? This Jesus, Son of God, who chose not only to accept Incarnation as a human, but became a man in the lowliest of circumstances, being laind in a manger soon after birth? A place for sustenance for livestock became a place of repose for the Food of Everlasting Life. This Jesus, who was born into a poor carpenter's family and left what little material possessions he had to preach the Kingdom of God? This Jesus who had such total self-giving as to accept a death sentence to make atonement for others' sins, for our sins? He did so while forgiving his accusers, some of whom were probably with him at this dinner. This Jesus, when taken from the corss, was placed in a borrowed tomb!


