

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 14:25-33

"Anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple."



We all desire happiness. Many seek happiness by obtaining material things like oversized homes, gasguzzling vehicles, or the latest electronic gadgets. But the only true happiness can come by changing our priorities and focusing on Jesus' way in our life.

Does this mean that we should sell all our possessions? No! Being a disciple of Jesus means looking after those less fortunate than ourselves: feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and the shut-ins, loving our neighbor; sharing our possessions and, at the same time, recognizing that all we have comes from God.

Jesus cautions those who listen to him to think through the ramifications of becoming a disciple. Following in his footsteps is not going to be easy. Recall that Jesus was tempted, ridiculed, called a lunatic, and tortured; he gave his life for us so that we could have true happiness. As a follower we can expect the same, though most of us will not suffer from martyrdom.

Remember we are not alone in our journey. Jesus, the source of true happiness, is always at our side to help us confront the issues we face in life.


