

THIS SUNDAY'S REFLECTION

LUKE 17:5-10

"We have done what we were obliged to do."



How many times does Jesus surprise us with his answers? Here we have the apostles asking him to increase their faith and Jesus telling them that even the little they have would be enough to do marvelous things. And immediately Jesus calls them and us to be generous in his service. He implies that faith must lead us to generosity.

James tells us in his epistle that "faith without deeds is totally dead" (2:17). Many of us complain that we are not lucky; we never win either a raffle or a lottery. Yet, we also need to ask God for the graces we need, but at the same time we must do our part to respond to those graces.

Recently, a friend told me she had asked an employee to do something else besides the usual chores. To her surprise, the employee said, "You need to pay me extra for that." Jesus invites us to be generous and not merely to do "what we are obliged to do." Are we ready to go "the extra mile" without counting the cost and without asking for "extra pay"?
