To acknowledge our oneness in the Spirit all parishioners are asked to wear red on the Feast of Pentecost.


As included in our Mission Statement, may we be "empowered by the Holy Spirit to live the values of Jesus in a prayerful, welcoming, and nurturing environment."

Thank you to all who have made a pledge to this year's Catholic Services Appeal. I am happy to say that through the pledges and gifts received, we have met the diocesan assessed goal. Replace the garage and food pantry roof \$24,500




