
**New Catechists:** The Religious Education community is in need of volunteer catechists for the coming school year. A catechist must be a person of prayer and faith who desires to form young people in the mandates of the Gospel and by the love of God. Catechists are responsible for planning and conducting scheduled

religious education lessons, supervising children and maintaining classroom records. Volunteers are provided with all necessary training as well as opportunities for on-going enrichment. Catechists must be at least eighteen years old, an active member of a Catholic parish, willing to teach in conformity with the doctrine of the Church and have current child protection clearances. Since it can take several weeks to process the clearances, please volunteer early in the summer.

If you are willing to share your faith with the children of this parish, please consider volunteering as a catechist or aide for the coming school year. Commit early and have access to training at your leisure as well as ample time to review the textbook. #### Joining Our Catholic Family

Do you have questions about the Catholic faith? Have you thought about becoming a member of the Catholic Church? Would you like to explore the possibility of being baptized? Then come and join the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults members of the OCIA ministry.



Unbaptized adults or teens or those not raised in a Christian community are invited into a rich and powerful ministry of prayer, faith-sharing, learning and reflection. This one-year (or longer if desired) process allows participants to explore the teachings, practices and communal life of the Catholic Church so that individuals can make an honest decision about their faith journey. Because this process requires a full year, those considering baptism or acceptance into the Catholic Church next Easter would need to begin the process now.

Individuals raised and well-formed in a Christian denomination other than the Catholic Church are invited to explore the Catholic tradition and beliefs in a time-frame and context that best meets their needs. Full reception into the Catholic Church for those baptized and steeped in the Christian faith can take place when the individual and faith community discerns is appropriate.

Baptized adults who wish to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation may also pursue the formation appropriate for this sacrament.

#### 2025 BABY BOTTLE FUNDRAISER

The Knights of Columbus in Erie and Crawford Counties are conducting our 4th annual Baby Bottle Fundraiser. Your charitable donations thus far have enabled the Knights to purchase five state of the art Ultrasound Machines and a Mobile Ultrasound Clinic for the Women's Care Center of Erie. Since 2018, 702 babies have been born to women after they viewed their ultrasounds. They chose life for their babies even though they were originally abortion bound. The Women's Care Center continues to face a financial crisis due to a large cut in funding by the state of PA that began last year. They actively promote childbirth as an option, rather than abortion by providing pregnancy,

parenting, and adoption support services. In order to keep providing these vital services, the Women's Care Center depends on our financial support. Baby bottles will be distributed at the Church entrances on Mother's Day weekend (May 10-11th). Please take one home and fill it with spare change, cash, or checks. Envelopes will also be available as an option to the Baby Bottles. Online giving options are available through FlockNote. The bottles and envelopes should be returned the weekend of June 21-22nd (Weekend following Father's Day).
