

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS WORK CREW MINISTRY

MINISTRY DESCRIPTION:

The Building & Grounds Work Crew is responsible for overseeing the maintenance of the Parish buildings and grounds, improvement and enhancement of the facilities, and construction of any new projects. The Committee is also responsible for optimizing maintenance and utility expenditures

ACTIVITIES OF MINISTRY:

- Meet to review all necessary projects to maintain and improve Church facilities.
- Implement projects to the necessary crew, for example, the paint crew or the landscaping crew.
- Contacting and providing the necessary manpower, aka volunteers, to accomplish the projects.
- Securing outside contractors, when necessary, to complete projects beyond the expertise of the committee and crew members.

EXPECTATIONS OF MINISTRY:

- Share your knowledge and craftsmanship in the areas of carpentry, painting, construction, landscaping, electrical, etc., when a project is implemented.
- Availability to work either day or evening on projects.
- Projects may last a week, a month, etc. Your time commitment depends on your schedule, and the amount of hours you are willing to volunteer for.
- Participating and providing knowledge in reviewing and planning necessary projects.
- Volunteers with experience and knowledge in any buildings and grounds area are always welcome.
