MINISTRY DESCRIPTION/ OVERVIEW :

The RCIA Ministry Team welcomes and accompanies adults on their journey, as they prepare to receive Baptism and full communion with the Catholic Church, through the rite of initiation. Together, team members and candidates share their faith through prayer, study, scripture reflection and integration into the parish community.

ACTIVITIES OF MINISTRY:

 The team meets weekly with adult catechumen and candidates to share their Catholic faith

EXPECTATION OF MINISTRY:

- Weekly classes plus time to prepare for each gathering
- Team members take turns leading the lessons
