

ALTAR LINEN CARE



DESCRIPTION/OVERVIEW:

The Altar Linen Ministry, with deep love and reverence for the Holy Eucharist, ensures that adequate supplies of linens are available for Mass. This ministry is done at home on a monthly rotating schedule; approximately every four months. Training is provided on how to care for these special linens.

ACTIVITIES:

- Altar linens are collected from the container in the sacristy
- Linens are taken home to be washed and pressed weekly during assigned month
- Members return linens to the parish on a timely basis and place them in the storage drawers

EXPECTATIONS:

- Ensure there is an adequate supply of linens for the celebration of Mass
- Clean albs as needed
- Agree to a rotating monthly schedule

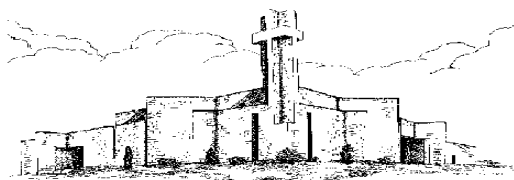
